Hi Wally and Linda,

I'm Sgt. Tim Huibregtse of the WI State Patrol. I have some questions I'm hoping you can help me out with. Last year we had some major snow storms and some of our roads had to be closed. This was mostly true in the Southwestern part of the State if you recall the incident on I-94. During that storm when the people were stranded in their vehicles local snowmobile clubs assisted with checking on people and delivery supplies to their vehicles. It was all voluntary service and provided as a community service.

What I would like to know are the clubs in Ozaukee and Washington Counties available to provide this service during a snow emergency? Is there already a plan in place with the clubs in the event they are called upon? Do the clubs currently work with any other police agencies regarding snow emergency?

I'm hoping you can provide me with this information so I don't have to contact each club individually. I currently supervisor Ozaukee and Washington Counties and I'm going to be gathering the information for both areas. The intent in gathering this information is so we can have a plan in place and have available the resources we would need in the case of a major snow emergency. We would not be calling upon the clubs for assistance unless road conditions became so bad that plows and traditional means of transportation were ineffective or not usable.
